



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Women of Asphalt Kentucky strives to empower women in asphalt industry careers by increasing **awareness** of opportunities in the industry, elevating **knowledge** through education and research, and providing platforms to create a supportive **community**. Based on these core values, Women of Asphalt Kentucky has instituted a scholarship program to offer monetary grants.

We understand that this grant is supplemental, given the cost of higher education. However, it is our goal to use these grants as a means to invest in women seeking careers in the asphalt industry.

Who is eligible to apply?

Applicants must be one of the following: graduating high-school senior of the class of 2026, individuals currently enrolled in a Kentucky Higher Education institution, and/or women currently employed in the asphalt industry and seeking supplemental education or certificates.

Eligible applicants may reapply for this grant each year but are not guaranteed repeat awards. No one is automatically considered for this grant, only those who apply each year will be considered.

Award Details:

If selected, scholarships will be awarded in a range of \$750 to \$1,500.

ALL INFORMATION REQUESTED IN THIS LETTER OR THE APPLICATION MUST BE FULLY COMPLETED IN ORDER TO BE CONSIDERED. Applications that do not include all requested information will not be considered. All applications must be submitted, *with all required documentation*, by April 15, 2026.

The Women of Asphalt Kentucky Scholarship Committee, after considering all applications, will announce the award winners via email. All award winners, and their families, will be invited to the Plantmix Asphalt Industry of Kentucky's Summer Meeting in Lexington, KY on June 12th, 2026 to accept their award in person.
